**It will be placed indoors at the end of November to remain protected from the snow.**

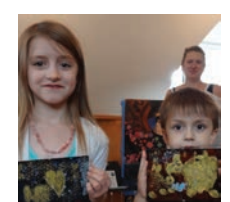
