

This year, the snow removal of Mille-Isles Road is under the responsibility of Quebec Ministry of Transport. Please contact the MTO:



RESIGNATION LETTER OF MISTER MICHEL BOYER



Sir, Madam,

Despite the acquittal of the sexual charges against me, for personal reasons I choose to devote myself to my family with what is left of my energy. They supported me in an admirable way while facing the unfounded accusations as well as during my mandates at town hall.

I no longer have the energy nor the health to assume the role of mayor in your best interests. For six years, I have exercised it with the greatest respect for the people of Mille-Isles and for our community, with the desire to evolve it in a harmonious and equitable manner.

I had the pleasure of working with two different boards. Everyone has fulfilled their duties and has contributed with the objective to maintain a pleasant living environment, to meet our obligations while providing you with the best services at a cost that takes into account as much as possible your ability to pay.

As Mayor, I acted as a member of the MRC d'Argenteuil's council. I met a management and staff who are committed to the development of our municipalities in a sustainable development perspective, taking in consideration not only climate change but also technological advances. I was able to participate, among other things, in the changes made to the MRC's layout plan as part of the Orientation 10, in the review of the fire safety risk coverage, in the guidelines for the deployment of high speed internet in addition to the stake for a municipal financing based more on the capacity of the citizen to pay rather than on the property value established on the strength of the real estate market. My fellow mayors, without necessarily sharing all my opinions, have shown respect and politeness in connection with my aspirations.

I leave town hall as of October 6, 2019 with the conviction that the person who will replace me is assured to have the support of a team of dedicated and professional employees. I was happy to know them and appreciate them. They deserve your gratitude.

I believe I have contributed positively to the well-being of our community. I thank you for the trust you have given me. You have allowed me to evolve and become a better person.

It is with great regret that we inform you of the resignation of Mr. Michel Boyer, mayor of the municipality of Mille-Isles.

We extend our sincere appreciation for the passion and rigour that he showed in his official duties along with his unshakeable engagement towards the community. During the last six (6) years, Mr. Boyer has been able to defend the interests of the citizens in government bodies of various issues. He also contributed in the advancement of important affairs through his constant participation in committees and through his interventions at various conventions with elected officials, initiatives that continue to inspire and guide the many professionals he has met.

Amongst his many achievements as mayor, we can mention his contribution to the reorganization of an administrative framework focused on personalized service and proximity with Mille-Isles citizens, as well as his work to resolve complex issues such as the yearly flooding of several residences near the Bellefeuille line, the creation of our satellite fire station in Bellefeuille to provide coverage to our citizens in the eastern sector of the municipality or the closure of CNESST dossiers which exposed our municipality to heavy fines and put employees at risk.

Since Monday October 7th, 2019, Councilor Howard Sauvé, appointed by resolution as deputy mayor and deputy to the MRC d'Argenteuil, has fulfilled the duties of Mayor. The appointment of Mr. Sauvé will have to be extended by resolution to assume the duties of Mayor until the day of the by-election, a date of which remains to be determined by the electoral officer.
