To those interested in a draft by-law RU.01.2011.02 modifying the urban plan.

PUBLIC NOTICE is given that:

At a regular meeting of the municipal council held October 7, 2020, the following notice of motion was adopted.

Draft by-law RU.01.2011.02 modifying urban plan number RU.01.2011 of the Municipality of Mille-Isles, as already amended, to add an area to be protected and to create and amend the provisions applying to the principles of road network extension.

This by-law project concern the addition of the Tamaracouta Scout Camp site as a heritage building and identifying it as an area to be protected, as illustrated below.



In addition, the proposed by-law aims to allow certain types of roads to change areas without amendment to the urban plan.

A public consultation meeting will be held on **Tuesday, February 2, 2021 at 2:00 P.M.** and it will be broadcast live by the internet link available on the Municipality website. During this public meeting, the Municipality will explain the draft by-law and the consequences of its adoption and will hear the people or organisations wishing to be heard, as prescribed in the *Loi sur l'aménagement et l'urbanisme*, live by the video broadcast system. All citizens are invited to ask their questions concerning the consultation to the general direction, by email at questions@mille-isles.ca or via the Municipality's Facebook page, before, during or after the public consultation.
