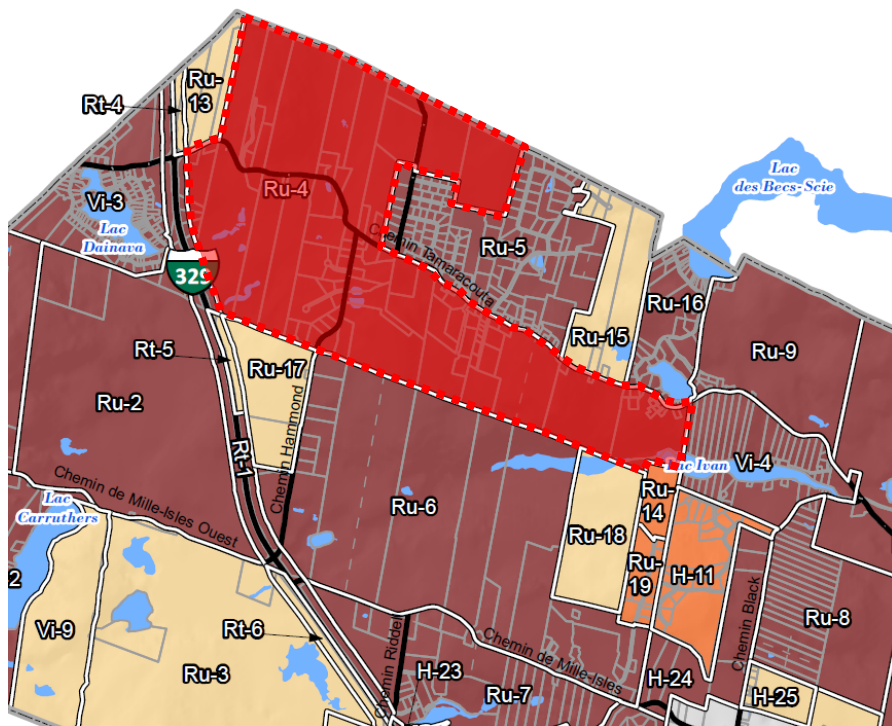
That this draft by-law contains one or more provisions subject to referendum approval.

**PUBLIC NOTICE is given of the following:**

During a regular meeting held on April 6, 2022, the council adopted the first draft resolution relating to the project to develop a beekeeping workshop on the property located at 1015 Tamaracouta Road pursuant to the By-law concerning specific construction, alteration or occupancy proposals for an immovable (SCAOPI) no. RU.10.2017.

The project consists of the development of a farm building used for the additional use "farmhouse and agriculture" with an area of 230 m<sup>2</sup>, for a total area of farm buildings of 310 m<sup>2</sup>, despite an area not conforming to the Zoning regulation RU.02.2011.

This draft resolution concerns the **Ru-4 zone**, located near the intersection of Tamaracouta Road and côte Saint-Gabriel. The area concerned is contiguous with zones Ru-5, Ru-15, Ru-16, Vi-4, Ru-14, Ru-18, Ru-6, Ru-17, Rt-1, Ru-13 and with the City of Saint-Sauveur, as shown in this sketch:



A consultation meeting will be held on **Wednesday, May 4, 2022 at 6:30 p.m.** at the Town Hall of the Municipality of Mille-Isles, located at 1262 Mille-Isles Road, Mille-Isles, Quebec.

During this meeting, the Municipality will explain the draft resolution and the consequences of its adoption and will hear the persons and organizations who wish to express themselves in accordance with the provisions of the *Planning and Development Act*.
