# MAYOR'S ADDRESS

July 2022 Edition

Hi everyone,

We had the public consultation for the draft by-law number RU.02.2011.14 on June 22. Many of you attended and your council thanks you for the constructive comments received. In this regard, the adoption of the second draft by-law will be postponed to the council meeting of August 3, 2022 to allow us to make positive changes to this draft by-law based on your comments. Moreover, the municipality has invited citizens to continue sending their comments until July 13 in order to improve the second draft by-law.

Also, public works will be able to pick up on the backlog from the severe storm in May and will be able to work on seasonal work shortly.

In addition, you will note that the requests in the Urbanism and Environment Departments are not decreasing and that the municipal staff is doing their best to process requests. In any case, we thank you for your patience.

Good news, Maple Grove will begin its evolution shortly. We have received a grant from Canada Economic Development in the amount of \$135,000 and the work must be completed before March 31, 2023, unless we obtain an extension. With the objective of promoting the built heritage of our municipality and with the advice of Geneviève Grenier, Cultural Development Officer of the Argenteuil MRC, we will proceed with the deconstruction of the Maple Grove. This step will be carried out by a firm specializing in the demolition and preservation of heritage buildings with the objective of incorporating historic portions into the future project. Following the deconstruction and the inventory of the recovered heritage pieces, we will be able to proceed with the creation of plans and specifications for approval by the council.

### FOURTH INSTALLMENT OF MUNICIPAL TAXES

The Municipality of Mille-Isles wishes to remind its citizens that the due date for the fourth installment of municipal taxes is Friday, August 12, 2022.

### GARBAGE AND RECYCLING BINS

Garbage and recycling containers have been standardized throughout the Municipality of Mille-Isles since January 1, 2018.

Your receptacle must match the following description or they will not be picked up:

#### Garbage bin

Description: rolling with handles  
Volume: 240 liters or 360 liters  
Colors: green, black or gray



#### Recycling bin

Description: rolling with handles  
Volume: 360 liters  
Color : blue



### Recipe from the cooking workshop of April 28, 2022: Le Dhal

#### Grill in a pan without oil:

- 2 or 3 bay leaves
- 1 teaspoon coriander seeds
- 1 teaspoon peppercorns
- 1 teaspoon mustard seeds
- 1 teaspoon cinnamon bark

#### Add:

- 2 - 3 tablespoon coconut oil
- 2 onions diced
- 3 or 4 cloves of garlic
- 2 tablespoon freshly grated ginger

#### Cook until onion becomes translucent and add:

- 2 carrots, diced
- 3 celery stalks, diced

#### Add:

- 2 cups red lentils
- 2 cans of 750 ml diced tomatoes
- Water to cover the lentils
- 1 tablespoon or more spices (curry, turmeric, cumin, paprika and chili flake)

**Let simmer. Before serving, add 2 cups chopped spinach or kale and lemon.**
