



- Unsorted or large quantities of building materials
- Household waste for regular pick-up
- Boats (pedal boats, kayaks, etc.)

* The attendant has the power to refuse materials or objects that are not on this list.

Resource center

Also known as "The Dome", it is a site for receiving new and used items brought in by the population of the territory served by the ecocenter. Furniture, appliances and miscellaneous items are then offered at low cost to residents. This project helps to reduce the environmental footprint by diverting materials from landfill, but also provides residents with an ecological alternative. The proceeds generated by the Dome are subsequently reused for the development of social, environmental and community projects.

What is an Ecocenter?

An ecocenter is a place where specific materials are recovered and recycled, diverting them from landfill. It is not, therefore, a place to bring your household garbage or any other object or material destined for the regular household pickup.

Who can use it?

The ecocenter is accessible to all residents of the Municipality of the Township of Gore, Mille-Isles and Wentworth, absolutely **free of charge**. Access is reserved for individual residents, not for businesses or entrepreneurs.

How to prepare for a visit ?

It is important to **pre-sort materials** before your visit and to ensure that they are accepted materials. Bring a **proof of residence** (driver's license, tax or hydro bill) and **photo ID**. The quantity of materials accepted per visit is **1.8m³**, equivalent to a 4x8x2 trailer or pick-up truck bed.
