Request for bids

The Municipality of Mille-Isles is requesting bids for the stabilization work of Côte Saint-Joseph in Mille-Isles, covering an approximate length of 200 linear meters, along with related work.

Tender documents will be available starting Monday, July 14, 2025, exclusively through the electronic tendering system (SEAO), by contacting one of the representatives by phone at 1 866-669-7326 or 514 856-6600, or by visiting the website <u>www.seao.ca</u>. Documents may be obtained at the cost set by SEAO. The Municipality of Mille-Isles is not responsible for the distribution of the tender documents by SEAO, and it is the bidders' responsibility to ensure they have all documents before submitting their bid.

Only bids submitted using the tender documents will be accepted.

Bids must be valid for a period of ninety (90) days and must be accompanied by a bid bond issued by an insurance company for an amount at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the bid value, as well as a letter of intent regarding the issuance of a performance bond and a bond guaranteeing labor, materials, and services, each for a value of fifty percent (50%) of the bid value. Only bonds issued by companies holding an insurer's license in Canada and recognized by the Autorité des marchés financiers du Québec will be accepted under the tender documents.

Bids will be received at the Mille-Isles Municipal Town Hall, 1262 chemin de Mille-Isles, Mille-Isles (Quebec), JOR 1A0, **no later than Wednesday, July 30, 2025, at 11:00 a.m. (Town Hall time)**, to be publicly opened on the same day and at the same time.

Bidder contractors are responsible for the selection of their subcontractors, both for their financial stability and for the content of their bids. The Municipality does not commit to accepting either the lowest or any of the received bids, without incurring any obligation whatsoever toward the bidder(s).
