## Request for tenders

The Municipality of Mille-Isles is requesting tenders for the acquisition of a demonstrator or used pumper-tanker fire truck, not older than 2007, in compliance with ULC 5515 and NFPA standards, and in accordance with the technical specifications detailed in the tender document.

The execution of the contract is conditional upon the approval of a loan by-law by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing.

Tender documents will be available as of Monday, October 27, 2025, by contacting the Electronic Tendering Service (SEAO), by phone at 1-866-669-7326 or 514-856-6600, or by visiting the website www.seao.ca. The bid price must be a fixed amount and include the provision of the requested equipment, including machinery, labour, and all costs related to the execution of the work.

Tenders must be submitted in a sealed envelope to the town hall located at 1262, chemin de Mille-Isles, Mille-Isles, Quebec J0R 1A0, before 10:00 a.m., legal time, on Wednesday, November 26, 2025, and must be clearly marked "ACQUISITION OF DEMONSTRATOR OR USED PUMPER-TANKER FIRE TRUCK – SSI202510-09".

Any request for information, clarification, or questions regarding this call for tenders must be sent in writing to the contact person in charge of this call for tenders no later than eight (8) days before the deadline for receipt of tenders. Otherwise, the Municipality reserves the right to refuse to respond. Any modification to the tender documents will be the subject of an addendum.

The Municipality does not undertake to accept the lowest or any of the tenders received and assumes no obligation of any kind towards the bidder(s). It reserves the right to waive a minor irregularity in the case of the lowest compliant bidder. The Municipality does not assume any liability towards the bidder by virtue of this tender call. The Municipality is not required to award the contract to a compliant bidder if the bid price is higher than the market price or the estimated cost.
