To all persons interested in **draft by-law RU.12.2026 concerning the occupancy and maintenance of buildings.**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that at a regular meeting held on March 4, 2026, the Municipal Council adopted draft by-law number RU.12.2026 entitled:

Draft By-law number RU.12.2026 concerning the occupancy and maintenance of buildings.

The By-law respecting the occupancy and maintenance of buildings is intended to ensure oversight of the occupancy and maintenance conditions of heritage properties and to prescribe health and maintenance standards.

This draft by-law applies to the entire territory of the Municipality and contains no provision that would make it a by-law subject to approval by referendum.

In accordance with the *Act respecting land use planning and development*, this draft by-law will be the subject of a public consultation meeting to be held on **Wednesday, April 1, 2026, at 6:30 p.m.** at the Strong Community Hall, located at 1262, chemin de Mille-Isles, Mille-Isles (Québec) J0R 1A0. During this meeting, the Mayor or his representative will explain the draft by-law and hear any persons and organizations wishing to be heard.
